Special fares negotiated for attendees with «Beramendi Car» Company.





The meeting will be held at CIC energiGUNE located around 15 km far away from Vitoria-Gasteiz.









There is a **public shuttle service** between Vitoria-Gasteiz and the Alava Technology Park.

Please find all the information here <u>https://parke.eus/alava/en/park-services/servicios-generales/transporte/</u> Schedule:

- From the Vitoria-Gasteiz Bus Station to the Technology Park: 06:55h & 08:25h.
- Return from the Technology Park to Vitoria-Gasteiz: 14:10h, 15:15h & 17:05h.

A non-personal travel card, available for purchase via bank card on the bus at a cost of $1 \in (non-refundable)$, is required to use this shuttle bus service.

The price of each trip is 1,40 € and cards can be recharged for 5 trips (7€) or 40 trips (56€).

Another possibility is coming by car or taxi.

In case you came by car, free parking spots are available at CIC energiGUNE's facilities.

A <u>negotiated taxi fare</u> from Vitoria-Gasteiz to CIC energiGUNE is available at a cost of 27,50 € with the company «Beramendi Car».

Payment must be made in cash to the driver.






